*This Seminar follows on from the sold-out 2016
“Water Recycling for Potable Reuse” Technical Seminar,
and focuses on the on the social barriers and challenges of
implementing potable water reuse.*

To-date, proposed use of recycled wastewater for drinking has been met with significant public concern and controversy and is likely to remain a contentious issue in the future.
