As a global community of practice, we are learning fast about how the COVID-19 pandemic is affecting organisations providing water supply, sanitation and sewerage services. Australian utilities are now developing business continuity and contingency plans in response to COVID-19 that are in line with State and Territory Government advice. This is to ensure they remain well prepared to continue delivering essential services and can continue to engage suppliers and contractors who are undertaking critical tasks across their network. Utilities are also working closely with their customers to ensure they remain connected to their water supplies during this period.

This Ozwater'20 Online session focuses on sharing experiences from several Australian water utilities on their preparation, response and recovery approaches ensuring the continuity of this essential service and the health and safety of water and wastewater utility workers. It also presents ground-breaking research from Water Research Australia on their ColoSSoS Project - an innovative, and collaborative Australia-wide investigation that aims to integrate reliable results of sewage testing for the SARS-CoV-2 virus with health data for COVID-19.
